## Week 3 - Do Good Discussion Guide

Following Jesus means doing what He did. Doing good, especially by serving others, is one of the ways Jesus fulfilled His purpose on earth. If serving isn't a part of the way you follow Jesus, it's likely you've lost track of His leading. The great thing about serving others is that it's never too late to start! It's also doable for everyone and there are immediate rewards for obeying God in this area. Do good. If you are serving others now, keep on doing good. If you're thinking about it, take a small step and join in! You'll be fulfilling your purpose when you do.

### Jump Start

1. Think of a story when someone "did good" for you or someone you know.
2. Read [Ephesians 2:10](#) and [Galatians 6:10](#). We are reminded that we were created to do good. And we are assured that we will have the opportunity to do so. What opportunities do you have to do good in your current situation? How does following through on those opportunities help you live out your purpose?
3. Read [Proverbs 11:25](#). What does this passage remind us about refreshing others? How have you seen this to be true in your personal experience?
4. Read [1 Corinthians 12:27-30](#) and [Romans 12:3-8](#). God gives each person who accepts His Son spiritual gifts. Which spiritual gift do you feel you might you have? How do you use it to do good?
5. Final Thought: Jesus said the least one will be the greatest in [Luke 9:48](#). Talk about what He meant and why you think that statement is easy / difficult to accept. What action can you take this week to start serving? Or how will you respond to something that God has put you up to doing?

### Deeper

6. Take this online [spiritual gifts test](#). When you get your results, look up the scripture verses that relate to your gifts to see what God says about them. Next, pray about using your gifts. How and where is God calling you to serve?
