Part 2 - Funding Your Dream

Discussion Guide

Most people struggle when it comes to living a life of being satisfied with what we have. This weekend we focus on how we can be satisfied and fund our dreams through Joe Sangl's GIVE, SAVE, INVEST, PLAN THE REST financial plan.

Jump Start

Leader: This section is designed to get discussions started, examine God's truth, and apply it to our week.

1. If money was not a question, what dream would you like to fulfill?
2. **Read [Proverbs 29:18](#)**. Why do the wise show restraint? How do you find revelation or vision?
Compare your life before and after God, does your life look different after having revelation?
3. **Read [Habakkuk 2:2](#)**. What does God want Habakkuk to do with his vision? Why is it important to write down your dreams or visions for your life? How does this help us keep from disbelieving?
4. **Read [Psalm 37:4](#)**. What are your hearts desires? How does what we want change when we desire God above all else? What are ways that we can seek out God's desires for our lives?
5. **Read [Romans 12:1-2](#)**. Of these three things Paul tells us to do, which one do you find most difficult? How can you offer yourself as a sacrifice? How does putting God first affect your dreams, finances, desires, generosity, etc.?

Challenge: Spend time seeking God, and writing down your plans, hopes, and dreams.

Deeper

Leader: This section is designed for further use in your Life Group or for personal study. These can also be used as discussion points and ways to stay connected with your group throughout the week.

6. Take a look at the scriptures that produce the “GIVE. SAVE. INVEST. PLAN THE REST.” financial plan. Write out thoughts and observations that come to mind as you read them. Write down any specific directions that God speaks to you through these scriptures. With these scriptures think about, what financial decisions do you need to make to a) bring glory and honor to the Lord? b) fund dreams that He has placed on your heart?

GIVE

Proverbs 3:9 “Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce;”

SAVE

Proverbs 21:20 “Precious treasure and oil are in a wise man’s dwelling, but a foolish man devours it.”

INVEST

Proverbs 13:11 “Wealth gained hastily will dwindle, but whoever gathers little by little will increase it.”

PLAN THE REST

Proverbs 21:5 “The plans of the diligent lead surely to abundance, but everyone who is hasty comes only to poverty.”
